

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITY RULES AND REGULATIONS

FOR THE 1st SEMESTER OF THE 2017-2018 ACADEMIC YEAR OF THE PATHOLOGY DEPARTMENT

At the Dental Medicine Faculty the subject of Pathology is taught to 2nd year students and it consists of 14 hours of theoretic lectures (7 courses held once every two weeks) and 14 hours of practical classes (7 PL-s held once every two weeks). The educational activity in the first semester involves the following rules:

1. The first semester entails 7 theoretic lectures discussing 5 great chapters of general pathology (Hemodynamic disorders, Dystrophy, Inflammation, Immunopathology and Tumor pathology). Compulsory references will be presented to the students by the lecturer at the beginning of the semester. *Evaluation of the semestrial activity of students will imply **one test taken during theoretic course (at the end of the semester)**, the date of which will be announced at least one week in advance by the lecturer.* The test will be composed of 15 single choice or multiple choice questions. *Grading will be made according to the "all or nothing" principle.* The grade obtained on the test will reflect the students activity throughout the semester, and it will make up **10% of the final grade** of the year examination, which will be calculated according to the formula: **10% first semester activity, 20% second semester activity, 30% practical examination and 40% theoretic examination.** Regardless of the grade obtained, the tests can not be repeated. Absence from the test will be noted with a grade of „0”. For justified absences, at the end of the semester, the lecturer will set a date and hour, on which one or more of the tests can be repeated *only by those students who were absent due to medical reasons, and who can present a medical report or some other proof approved by the Deans office for justifying their absence.* Participation on the semestrial test and test result **does not condition the participation on the theoretic and practical examination**, so regardless of the grade obtained on the test, this will make up 10% of the final grade and the student can be admitted to the theoretic and practical examination.
2. The 1st semester comprises 7 practical classes which are composed each of one hour of microscopy lessons alternating with one hour of macroscopic specimen presentation. It is strictly forbidden to do any media recording (photographic, videographic or audiographic) at the practical classes. Throughout the semester the wearing of protective white coats is compulsory and will be provided by every student himself. It is advised that these white coats to be used exclusively in the Pathology department. It is not allowed to change the time and date of the practical classes, nor changing groups. In exceptional cases, recovering a missed practical class can be done in the same week, but only after prior permission by the teaching staff. *Practical examination will take place in the last week of the second semester* and will be held by the lecturer responsible for the practical classes throughout the semester,

who will be accompanied by a colleague from the same department. *Students having more than one unrecovered absence from practical classes during the first semester will not be admitted to the practical examination.* Theoretic examination will take place in the examination period of the second semester on a date and hour set in conjunction with the lecturer. Students having more than one unrecovered absence from theoretic classes during the first semester will not be admitted to the theoretic examination.
