



MEASURES REGARDING THE HEALTH PROTECTION OF STUDENTS ON SUMMATIVE EXAMS

The summative exams for students from MEDICINE, English (years of study I-V) are scheduled between **1st - 3rd of September 2020**, in "Anton Pongracz" Sport Hall (UMFST campus) and Festive Hall (UMFST Main building, 2nd floor), according with the following schedule:

V	2nd September 2020	15.00 -18.30	Festive Hall UMFST (+ Small Amphitheater – spare room)

The epidemiological screening is performed in accordance with the legal provisions in force.

In order to ensure the access of all students at the time set for the exam, please present yourself in time (according with our recommendations) and respect the legal distance between people by sitting on the markings displayed by the Faculty. It is **mandatory** to wear a **face mask to cover the nose and mouth**, on university premises (**the face mask is not provided by the University!**). Otherwise you are not allowed access, respectively you will be forced to leave the building if you do not follow the rule at all time during your presence in the building;

The **circuit for students** will be:

- **"Anton Pongracz" Sport Hall**
 - entrance: main entrance
 - exit: lateral exit
- **UMFST main building - for Festive Hall and Small Amphitheater (spare room)**
 - entrance: parking no. 2 (central door)
 - access to the second floor: central stairs
 - exit: main exit of the main building

Please access your exam room by following the markings of the displayed access circuit!

Move strictly where you have a problem to solve; your presence in other locations of the building where you do not have received permission for access will cause your evacuation from the building by the security staff.





The entrance in both exams room will take place respecting the following schedule:

- **Festive Hall**
 - years I-III: Codes **97 - 119**: 08.20 - 08.35 a.m.
Codes **120 - 140**: 08.35 - 08.50 a.m.
 - 5th year: Codes **5001-5021**: 14.20 - 14.35 a.m.
Codes **5022-5035**: 14.35 - 14.50 a.m.

For all students the body temperature will be measured by UMFST staff at the entrance in the examination room.

Please present the completed and signed **Questionnaire for the Epidemiological Screening** to the person at the entrance to the examination room. The questionnaire can be downloaded here:

Persons with body temperature with values higher than 37.3° C (with a second check after 2-5 min.) on the day and time of the summative exam will be guided in a separate room – *Small Amphitheater*. These students may take the exam under the supervision of teachers with special measures of protection.

Please disinfect your hands using the devices provided by the Faculty, at the entrance to the exam or in the examination rooms! Sit in the specially arranged place, at the indication of the teacher (according with the documents: *Placement of Students* and *Codes for summative exams*). Please wear the mask correctly during the whole exam (covering the mouth and the nose).

At the end of the exam, after handing in the question books and the exam grids, you have the obligation to leave the room following the exit circuit through the displayed markings.

Strictly follow the personal hygiene rules recommended by the authorities:

- if you sneeze or cough, cover your mouth and nose with a disposable napkin, which you are careful to throw away immediately in the trash;
- do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth with unhygienic hands;
- wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and disinfect your hands whenever needed.
- avoid parking in common areas;
- limit your contact with other people
 - ✓ at a maximum of 15 minutes, if the distance is less than 1.5 m;
 - ✓ avoid the situations of forming some groups inside the institution and in the Campus of the Faculty;
- *If you experience respiratory manifestations during the days before the exam (cough, sneezing, rhinorrhea, fever, difficulty breathing) - stay at home and call your family doctor for advice!*
