NEW: students enrolled at Medicine and Dental Medicine in the second year of study

The Erasmus Office organizes the selection competition for student **Erasmus traineeship mobilities**. Students enrolled at the following programs of study can apply:

- MEDICINE- years of study: II, III, IV, and V;
- PHARMACY- years of study: II, III, and IV;
- DENTAL MEDICINE years of study: II, III, IV, and V;
- HYDROTHERAPY, KINESIOLOGY AND MEDICAL REHABILITATION, NUTRITION AND DIETETICS, GENERAL NURSING – years of study: I and II;
- MEDICAL COSMETICS TECHNOLOGY OF COSMETIC PRODUCS years of study: I and II.

Details

The Erasmus traineeship mobility can take place in a university, a teaching or private hospital, clinic, or private practice in any European country or any other country which is eligible for the Erasmus+ program (Turkey, for example). The mobility can take place only if the student submits to the Erasmus Office an **invitation/ acceptance letter from the receiving institution**, signed by the head of the department hosting the mobility.

The duration of the mobility is 2 months.

This type of mobility aims to help students adapt to the requirements of the European labour market, and gain useful professional and linguistic skills.

Submit your file

Files can be submitted starting with October 28, 2020 up until November 27, 2020, by sending all the documents in a single PDF file to the email anca.rachita@umfst.ro. The name of the PDF file needs to state your LAST NAME, FIRST NAME, FACULTY and YEAR OF STUDY (i.e. Rachita Anca, Medicine, year II). The PDF file should contain all the necessary documents for your application file: opis, application form for the selection for Erasmus traineeship mobilities, annexes supporting the scores in the application form, EUROPASS CV, copy of your ID/ passport, motivation letter.

NB 1: applications sent to any other email address than the one given in the present announcement **will not be taken into account.**

NB 2: Taking into account the SARS-CoV-2 pandemics, students do not need to submit for this selection the following documents:

- <u>- Certificate from the Dean's office with the average on the finished academic years.</u> The average of the finished academic years will be calculated by every student, using the information in the Carnet online/ Online Notebook academic records. The average will then be confirmed by the secretaries of the dean's offices at the request of the Erasmus Office.
- <u>- statement for demonstrative-preparers</u>. The Erasmus Office will request the dean's offices the list of the demonstrative-preparers.

Eligibility criteria:

- Romanian/ foreign students enrolled at UMFST G.E.Palade Tg. Mures.
- STUDENTS WHO PASSED ALL EXAMS IN THE FINISHED YEARS OF STUDY.

The file needs to contain the following documents:

- Opis;
- Application form for the selection for Erasmus traineeship mobilities;
- annexes supporting the scores in the application form (diplomas, certificates, copies of published articles, copies of abstracts of the papers presented during congresses and of the participation diplomas from these congresses, etc) scanned in order of the criteria from the application form.
 Every page of the annexes will be numbered, and the annex page number will be written in the application form at the respective criteria. Please follow the instructions in the application form!
- EUROPASS CV (including the student's full address, email, phone), written in Romanian;
- Copy of the identity card/ passport
- Motivation letter.
